

# propagating a spider plant

1. Use a container that allows the leaves to stay dry and the roots to be fully submerged.
2. Find a place for your plant to grow that gets warm, indirect sunlight.
3. It can take 1 week in the summer for roots to grow and up to 4 weeks in the winter for roots to grow. Add to soil when there are several roots that are 2" long.
4. You can pot your spiderette with standard potting soil.



5. When watering keep the soil moist but never wet.
6. You can also choose to keep your spiderette growing in water.
